The U.S. African Development Foundation (USADF) is an independent U.S. government agency established by Congress to invest in African grassroots organizations, entrepreneurs, and SMEs. USADF's investments promote local economic development by increasing incomes, revenues, and jobs. Utilizing a community-led development approach, USADF provides seed capital and local project management assistance to African-owned and -led enterprises addressing some of Africa's biggest challenges around food insecurity, insufficient energy access, and unemployment—particularly among women and youth. Over the last five years (2016–2020), throughout Africa's Horn, Sahel, and Great Lakes regions, USADF has invested more than US\$117 million dollars directly into over 1,000 African- owned and -operated entities and impacted over four million lives.







Building Capacity



INCREASING INCOMES

Challenge: Guinea Confection, a uniform manufacturing business, was constrained by its production workspace, inadequate equipment, and lack of working capital to expand its client base and meet the growing demand for uniforms.

Action: USADF invested US\$231K in Guinea Confection for it to renovate its workshop and procure new equipment and raw materials.

Results: With USADF's investment, Guinea Confection increased its annual sales revenue by 416 percent, annual net income by 263 percent, full-time employees by 54 percent, and total salaries by 740 percent.

BUILDING CAPACITY

Challenge: Due to limited financial and technical capacity, Federation of Shea Butter Producer Unions of Upper Guinea (FUPROBEK) was unable to meet demand for its shea butter.

Action: USADF invested US\$248K in FUPROBEK for it to improve its shea butter processing technologies, set up rural and provide technical and organizational assistance to Federation leadership and members.

Results: Through USADF's investment, FUPROBEK established a production center in Mandiana and provided technical training to its management team.
